



Star Award

The SkillsUSA Star Award is given to senior students who have made great contributions to our organization at the local, state, or national level. It is the highest award a SkillsUSA student member can receive.

Requirements

1. Maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average in three consecutive semesters of high school.
2. Apply to Wisconsin SkillsUSA by filling out the application form.
3. Submit three letters of recommendation to be completed by:
 - a. Local Advisor
 - b. High school principal
 - c. Your choice
4. Be an active and registered member of SkillsUSA for at least two full years.
5. Be interviewed and recommended by the Wisconsin SkillsUSA organization.
6. Participate in the SkillsUSA Professional Development Program having completed at a minimum level one. Additional levels earned will be taken into consideration.
7. Must have held a local or state SkillsUSA office.
8. Completed a SkillsUSA community service project, selected with the advisor.
9. Participated in at least one leadership and/or technical skill contest at the Wisconsin SkillsUSA Championships.
10. Gave a presentation about SkillsUSA to a local community group, business/industry or professional organization or potential members group (optional for the 2009, but will be taken into strong consideration).
