ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be a graduating Wisconsin high school senior
- Be attending post-secondary school in fall 2008
- Have 3.0 cumulative grade point average or higher
- Be a SkillsUSA member for at least two years, including current year

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered, your complete application must be postmarked by March 14, 2008. Your application must include:

- Completed application form, including essay
- Current academic transcript
- Letter of recommendation from your SkillsUSA advisor or instructor (local or state level)
