## ELIGIBILITY

Open to active SkillsUSA members.

## OBSERVER RULES

Projects will be on display in a designated area for all to view on Wednesday of State Conference. **Projects must remain on display until at least 2:00 PM or they will not be judged.**

## SCOPE OF CONTEST

1. Contestants will be identified by number only.
2. A 3x5 Card must be attached to the project for easy identification.

**(Sample Display Card)**

3. Display must also have an informational binder located on or next it (see page 2 for specific criteria).
4. No student or school name should be on any drawings or documentation. Contestant number should be placed in the upper right hand corner of all documents.
5. The project value (what you realistically think it could be sold for), should also be located under the contestant’s number in the upper right hand corner. Please see the chart below for the categories.

6. If contestant information is not legible, the project will not be judged.

Registrations will be completed like all other competitions - online. Select Middle School and High School Divisions.
