2023 Wisconsin State Contest Addendum

***Please see the SkillsUSA National Technical Standards for the specifics of the purpose, eligibility, scope of the contest, and the standards and competencies.**

Clothing Requirement

- Class C: Contest Specific Manufacturing/Construction Khaki Attire These regulations refer to clothing items that are pictured and described at www.skillsusastore.org. If you have questions about clothing or other logo items, call 1-888-501-2183.
- Leather work shoes (athletic shoes will not be allowed in the contest area)
- Hard hat
- Safety glasses with side shields or goggles (Prescription glasses can be used only if they are equipped with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles.)

Competitors MUST always wear their hard hat and safety glasses in the carpentry contest area on the day of the contest (not needed during the briefing on Tuesday). Failure to wear hard hat and safety glasses may result in disqualification of the contest.

Safety Requirement

Both the instructor and the contestant certify by agreeing to enter this contest that the contestant has received instructions and has satisfactorily passed an examination on the safe use of a portable power saw. They also certify that the contestant's saw has been thoroughly inspected and is in safe working condition.

They further certify that SkillsUSA, SkillsUSA Wisconsin, the state technical committee, state technical chairs, and judges are released from all responsibility relating to personal injury resulting from the use of the portable power saw.

Contestants will be removed from competition if it is found proper safety training has not been provided and/or they are using the equipment in an unsafe manner.

Equipment & Materials

1. Supplied by the technical committee:
 - a. All lumber and materials, as specified on the job sheet.
 - b. Job sheets and prints for each contestant and judge.
 - c. All necessary information and furnishings for judges and technical committee.

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2. Supplied & brought by the contestant:

NOTE: Contestants are NOT allowed to share tools with other contestants.

****Both corded and cordless tools are allowed. Extra batteries will not be supplied.**

- a. Safety Equipment listed under "Clothing Requirement"
- b. Sawhorses (wood will NOT be provided)
- c. Pencils & Black Marker
- d. Calculator (not a cell phone)
- e. Carpenters tool and nail pouch with belt and/or suspenders
- f. 50' power cord (UL approved, grounded. Power cords not grounded will NOT be allowed to be used)
- g. Power circular hand saw (must have either tool steel or carbide tipped blades). If desired, a contestant may choose to use a standard hand saw without penalties.
- h. Coping Saw
- i. Drill and #2 Phillips screwdriver tip
- j. Screwgun with Phillips tip with magnetic extension
- k. Claw hammers (1 trim and 1 framing)
- l. One set of chisels (1/4" to 1")
- m. Framing square
- n. Folding rule and/or any steel tape measure
- o. Combination square and/or speed square
- p. Utility knife
- q. Assorted screwdrivers (Phillips and slotted)
- r. One pair of slip-joint pliers
- s. Wrecking bar or gooseneck pinch bar
- t. Cat's paw (nail puller)
- u. Chalk box and line
- v. Level (24" required but a 48" recommended)
- w. Combination wood rasp and file (8")
- x. Stair gauges (optional)
- y. One 8, 10, or 12pt. crosscut saw (optional)
- z. Resume
