We are excited to host the Welding Fabrication Contest this year. Below, you will find some general information on how this contest will be run to help your students understand what and how this contest will flow. If you have any questions - you may reach out to me (Please know I will have separate judges for the competition as I also have students competing in Welding Fab)

PROCTORED CONTEST (new this year, Advisors can proctor your own students. You do not need to find another adult to do this.)

Your students will weld this assembly at your school facilities. Each competing team must supervised by an adult who will observe the student team compete and ensure the team only works during the given amount of time as well as follows the guidelines of the contest laid out. This might include limited materials, limited access to equipment, and limited time (3 hours from start to finish).

The competing team will be responsible for arranging your competition (hands-on) time/day for doing the contest. Teams MAY practice before their scheduled timeslot/day. However, make sure you have the proper materials available from the material list for your official timeslot. None of the materials can be cut or prepped ahead of time. Teams may NOT run the official timeslot twice (no rescheduling if the first time does not go well - this is a one-and-done).

Teams are responsible for supplying their own materials in accordance with that material list. No extra materials shall be used during the official timed event.

CONTEST PRINTS

The teams will be supplied the prints with the needed information to complete the product. If teams or advisors have questions about anything on the print or if you find a mistake, please contact me.

The judges at Stout will be independent and not affiliated with any school district.
