

# SkillsUSA Wisconsin Regional Competition at UW-Stout: Parking Information for February 26 - 27, 2026

## Buses

- Arrive by **3:15 PM** on Thursday and **7:45 AM** on Friday.
- Drop off contestants in front of the Memorial Student Center (**302 10th Ave E, Menomonie, WI**).
- Contestants must be chaperoned by a designated adult and bring all their competition items with them.
- Buses will need to park off campus.

## Cars and Vans

- **Online parking reservations are now open for this event and must be purchased BEFORE the date of the event and before parking on campus. The code will not work at the pay station.**
  1. Obtain the license plate of the vehicle you will be using. Then, go to <https://uwstout.pmreserve.com>.
  2. Select the date you will be on campus (2/26/2026 or 2/27/2026). Then, click **Next**. Note: if you are attending both days, you will need to repeat this process before checking out.
  3. For the Access Code, type **SKILLS26**. Then, click **Update**.
  4. Click **Add to Cart**. Note: although it states the complimentary parking will be valid from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, it will actually be valid before and after those times.
  5. Click **Continue Shopping** to add another date or click **Continue Checkout** (Guest Checkout).
  6. Add your information. Note: when entering the license plate, do not use spaces or dashes. Then, read and agree to the ParkMobile Terms & Conditions, click the "I'm not a robot" box, and click **Complete Purchase**. Note: failing to authorize or entering incorrect information will result in a citation. The license plate entered will be your permit.  
If you have questions, contact UW-Stout Parking Services at 715-232-1792.
- Arrive at **UW-Stout Lot 27** (west of the Memorial Student Center) by **3:15 PM** on Thursday and **7:45 AM** on Friday. Park with your license plate visible to the drive lane in an unsigned, unmetered, non-reserved space in UW-Stout Lot 27.
- Contestants must be chaperoned by a designated adult and bring all their competition items with them.


## Parking Regulations

**Commuter Lots and Meters**  
Permits regulated: 7 a.m. – 4 p.m.; M-F  
Parking prohibited: 2 a.m. – 7 a.m. daily

**Housing Parking Lots**  
Housing Reserved regulated 24 hours everyday. Housing Standard regulated 24 hours every day; between 9 p.m. Sunday and 1 p.m. Friday.

**Reserved Spaces, Restricted Areas, Service Areas and Short Term Spaces:**  
Regulated 24 hours every day

Visitors should obtain authorization from their host prior to their visit and park in the lot(s) designated for that authorization. Visitors without authorization must park in a pay to park area.
